2a	Full Copy of Title including Plan of Subdivision, Covenants and any Section 173 Agreements attached to the title. (should have been issued within the last 3 months) (visit www.landata.vic.gov.au , solicitor or conveyancer to obtain current title information)	<input type="checkbox"/>
2b	Evidence of ownership of the allotment or evidence that a contract has been entered into pursuant to Section 9AA of the Sale of Land Act 1962 and Plan of Subdivision and settlement has taken place. (for land that has recently been purchased)	<input type="checkbox"/>
2c	If property is owned by a Business or Company an ASIC company search, which lists all Directors is required. (visit www.asicconnect.asic.gov.au/public/ to assist with your search)	<input type="checkbox"/>
3	Copy of Planning Permit and endorsed plans. (if applicable) (Note – Building and Planning applications can be lodged concurrently)	<input type="checkbox"/>
4	If building is in an unsewered area you will need to obtain a septic tank permit. A separate application is available on Council's website contacting the Environmental Health Department.	<input type="checkbox"/>

5c	Provide copy of Owner/Builders Certificate of Consent (not E-Learning receipt) from the Victorian Building Authority (VBA), if the value of the domestic work is greater than \$16,000.00.	<input type="checkbox"/>
6	A copy of allotment site plan, to a scale of no less than 1:500 showing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boundaries and dimensions of the allotment and any relevant easements; • The distance to the nearest intersecting street; • The position and dimensions of the proposed building and its relationship to the site boundaries and any other buildings on the site; • The location of Stormwater Drainage on site; • Plans must include information to address Part 5 – Siting requirement of the Building Regulations 2018. 	<input type="checkbox"/>
7	A copy of Seven Star Energy Rating Report and stamped plans and nominate either rain water tank or solar hot water systems.	<input type="checkbox"/>
8	A copy of an assessment under AS3959-2018 identifying the appropriate Bushfire Attack Level (BAL) for the proposed building. (if applicable)	<input type="checkbox"/>
9a	Full structural plans to scale (scale 1:100), computations and Certificate of Compliance, site specific.	<input type="checkbox"/>
9b	Certificate/s must include the following details, in accordance with Regulation 126. <p>Murray River Certifiers Building Surveyor 14 Deniliquin Street, Tocumwal NSW 2714 Email – admin@murrayrivercertifiers.com.au</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
10	A copy of a soil report and appropriate slab/footing design based on soil classification.	<input type="checkbox"/>
